# 2018 PAYABLE 2019 PROPERTY TAX INFORMATION

**The following is provided to direct taxpayer's questions or concerns to the appropriate office:**

**Need a copy of your bill?** Duplicate tax bills are available for free on the Internet. Simply go to our website at [jasperil.devnetwedge.com](http://jasperil.devnetwedge.com) and begin your search either by name or property index number. After you enter your information and view your payment status, then select **Print Tax Bill**. (If you have difficulty retrieving the bill, please remember to set the Treasurer's web site as a trusted site on your web browser.)

**Payment Options:** The Treasurer's Office offers several different options to pay your tax bill.

**Pay in person:**

**Walk-in or use the Drive-up window** and pay with cash, check, cashiers check or money order at our office located at 204 W Washington Street Suite 4, Newton, IL 62448. (If you do not have your tax bill when you pay, you will be charged a per copy fee.)

**Pay by Drop Box:**

**24-hour payment drop box** is located in the **Drive-up** on the west side of the County office building, located at 204 W. Washington St. Payments at the drop box are considered on-time if made on or before midnight on the due date.

**Pay by mail: MUST BE POSTMARKED ON OR BEFORE THE DUE DATE TO AVOID INTEREST PENALTY**

Mail the payment to our office at P.O. Box 107, Newton, IL 62448. Your cancelled check will be your receipt. If you prefer that a receipt be mailed to you, you will need to send a self-addressed stamped envelope along with your payment for us to mail a receipt back to you.

**Jasper County Banks** can accept your property tax payment if made on or before the due date.

**Electronic Payments: Credit/Debit Cards:** (MasterCard, Discover, American Express or Visa) and **eChecks** will be accepted by phone at **833-591-0728** or online at [jasperil.devnetwedge.com](http://jasperil.devnetwedge.com). (The online payment option will become available after you have reached your parcel's property information.)

**A convenience fee will be charged by the payment service.**

**Late Fee:** The 1st installment payments are due on or before August 15, 2019. If payment is not received by that day, a late fee of 1.5% will be assessed to that installment. The 2nd installment payments are due on or before September 16, 2019. If payment is not received by that date, a late fee of 1.5% will be assessed to that installment. Both installments may be paid on or before August 15, 2019, with no penalty assessed. 1.5% penalty will be applied to each installment each month until payment is received or sold at the County Tax Sale.

**Certain taxpayers may be eligible for:**

- The Senior Citizens and Disabled Persons Property Tax Relief and Pharmaceutical Assistance Act. Applications are available from the Illinois Department of Aging.
- Abatements and/or other assistance programs. You should consult with your township or county assessor and/or the Illinois Department of Revenue.
